



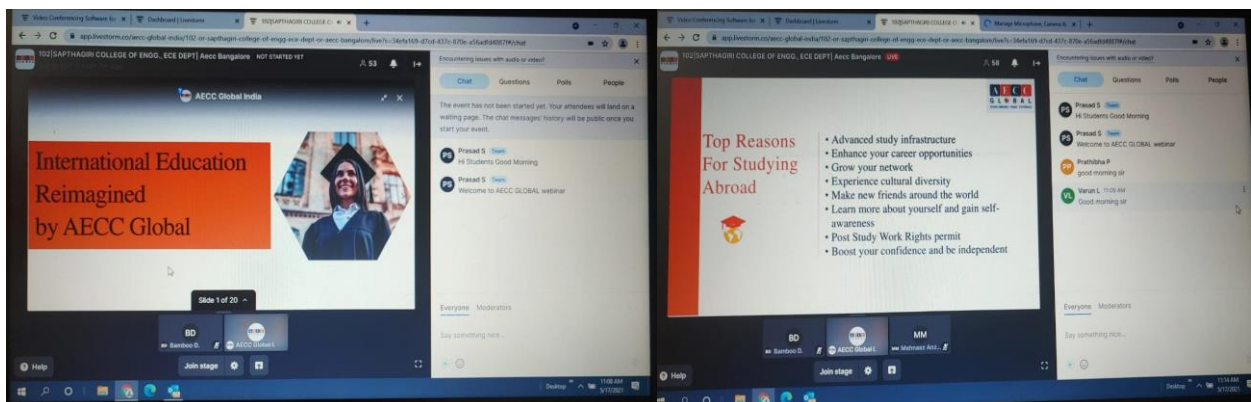
IN ASSOCIATION WITH
